ARE YOU AT RISK?

- You are older than 50
- You have a chronic disease (minimum 6 months)
- You are pregnant
- You work in healthcare
- You live with a person at risk



YES, WHAT DO YOU DO?

- You don't have to ask your General Practitioner (GP)'s prescription in advance. From September 2022 on, the pharmacist can also prescribe a flu vaccine.
- You get the vaccine at your pharmacy. You will pay the refunded price.
- You go to your GP. Your GP will give the injection.



NO, YOU ARE NOT AT RISK. WHAT DO YOU DO?

- Do you also want a flu vaccine?
This year there are sufficient vaccines available.
- You don't have to ask your GP's prescription in advance. From September 2022 on, the pharmacist can also prescribe a flu vaccine.
- You get the vaccine at your pharmacy with your prescription.
You will pay the full price.
- You go to your GP. Your GP will give the injection.

! The flu vaccine is not a COVID-19 vaccine. It also doesn't protect you from the common cold. You are only protected against the flu.
