


NEIGHBOURHOOD CARE MEETINGS BY BRUZEL

The Brussels Capital Region has a complex and fragmented health care landscape. The primary care zone of Brussels, BruZEL, connects primary care actors to ensure that people in need of care or assistance get the help and care they need in their own neighbourhood.

The aim:



- all citizens receive the help and care they need
- qualitative integrated care is provided in an effective way
- care providers are more satisfied

Role:

BruZEL initiates, stimulates, inspires and leads a broad local network of health care providers and welfare workers, local authorities, school staff ...

Impact:

- creation of a local health and care map (work-in-progress)
- possibility to detect recurring problems

Next steps:

- Developed in 2 communities. On to extending it to others.
- Structural meetings, organized by local actors
- Exploring the central role of the (health)care-related information and/or referral points
